that I Joshua Ingram for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred
dollars to me in hand paid by Eli Baldwin the receipt whereof I do
hereby acknowledge, Have bargained sold and released and by these
present do grant bargain sell release and Confirm unto the said
Eli Baldwin one certain tract a parcel of land lying in the district
aforesaid containing two hundred and forty one acres, it being the
plantation and land wheron I now live, and bounded as followeth
to wit "Beginning at a Red oak tree S. by E. 51° 00' to a post oak tree
S. 38° 36' E. a pine tree N. 29° W. 8° 50' to a Red oak tree S. 65° W. 35° 50'
to a black jack tree N. 26° E. 11° 50' to a Red oak tree N. 40° W. 45'
to a Red oak tree N. 70° E. 10' to a pine tree N. 21° E. 16° 75' to the
Beginning. With all and singular the privileges and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Eli
Baldwin his heirs and assigns forever, and to the only proper use and
benefit of him the said Eli Baldwin his heirs and assigns forever
To have & to hold use, occupy, proprie and enjoy the same with all
the appurtenancy tenements and hereditaments thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining — unto the said Eli Baldwin his heirs and assigns
forever. And I do for myself my heirs & warrant and for ever defend the
Right and title of the above land from the claim or demands of myself
my Heirs and all other persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part
thereof — As witness my hand and seal this thirtieth day of October one
thousand Eight hundred and thirteen —
