25. 20 to a Red oak corner also made for Brasheers thence S. E. 65. 28 to a stake  
on James Alexanders line thence N. E. 27. 28 to a post oak 31 the original corner  
thence N. 50 E. 17 to a hickory tree down creek 34 thence N. 35. W. 13 to a post  
oak 34 original thence N. 50 W. 15 to a dogwoods Thompsons corner thence N. 25

certain tract of land lying and being in Greenville district on the  
waters of Ragborns creek originally granted unto the said Nathaniel  
Miller and signed by his excellency Thomas Pinckney on the third day of  
March 1788. Containing three hundred and thirty five acres as by a plat  
annexed to the original grant will appear all that part of said tract of  
land Beginning on a Post oak old mark N. E. 85 twenty five chains  
and twenty five links to a Pin Stake corner thence N. W. 15. 17 chains and
