Devault Sons Salus Terry Arthur Terry Rebecca Terry Gustu Terry Mary Terry and Hannah Terry of the second part and James Alexander trustee for and in behalf of the said Nancy and her Children aforesaid of the third part Witnesseth where by some unhappy difference hath lately arisen between the said Thomas Terry and the said Nancy Terry his wife and their Children aforesaid and they have mutually agreed to live separate and apart from each other and agreeing to such separation he the said Thomas Terry and Nancy Terry his wife mutually agreed to refer all matters and differences which existed between them the said Thomas and Nancy wife to arbitration the award whereof they have agreed upon by the arbitrator selected for the decision of the difference aforesaid and being presented to the said Thomas Terry and Nancy his wife received their assent and approbation he the said Thomas Terry in compliance with the award aforesaid and as is now witnessed by this Indenture doth hereby for himself his Executors and administrators and for every of them Covenant and agreed with the said James Alexander trustee his executor and administrator and assigns and doth also agree with the said Nancy Terry John Salus Arthur Rebecca Gustu Charly & Hannah Terry in manner and form following, that it shall & may be lawful to and for the said Nancy Terry and her Children aforesaid and that he the said Thomas Terry shall and will permit and suffer her the said Nancy and their Children from time to time and at all times from henceforth during her and their natural life to live separate and apart from him and to reside and be in such place & place and in such family and families and with such relations friends and other persons and to follow and carry on such trade or trade and business as she the said Nancy and their Children aforesaid from time to time at their will and pleasure (notwithstanding the present covenant of the said Nancy wife or aforesaid) and the manner
