Sponge Wiggenton of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration  
of one hundred and fifty dollar to me in hand paid by Elijah Warren  
of Madison County Mississippi Territory, have granted bargained sold &  
released unto the said Elijah Warren all that plantation and tract  
of land containing one hundred and seventy five acres more or less  
situated and lying in the district aforesaid on the waters of the north  
fork of Saluda River and is bounded as follow, a conditional line beginning  
on a black jack on Hugh M. Gays line thence a straight course to a  
black oak thence straight to a dogwood corner and spring branch thence  
down the meander of said branch to the mouth of the same where it  
empties into the beam dam Creek to Williams Kellys line thence along  
his line to where it joins Hugh M. Gays line thence along the said  
M. Gays line to the beginning - To have and to hold from me my heirs  
executors administrators or assigns forever to said Warren his heirs or assigns  
which I warrant and defend the same from any person lawfully  
claiming the same or any part thereof - As witness whereof I have  
set my hand and seal this the twenty sixth July one thousand Eight  
hundred and sixteen and in the forty sixth year of the  
Independancy of America -
