fifty acres more or less lying in the district aforesaid on the waters
of Rocky creek of Enoree River, whereas it beginning on a chestnut
corner from thence S. 15 E. 11 to a small post oak corner from thence
to Reubin Smith land from thence along said Smiths line to a
stake corner on a conditional line made between said S. Walker
and John West from thence to a red oak corner from thence to a post
oak corner originally P. Hudsons corner from thence with the rear
of a small branch to the beginning corner chestnut, Together
with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenance to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining, To have and To hold all & singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Smith his heirs
and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c and
admits to warrant and forego defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Thomas Smith his heirs and assigns against myself
and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand
and seal this 14th day of Septemr in the year of our Lord 1805. And
in the 30th year of the Independence of the United States of
