S.W. to a red oak corner S.E. on lands laid out to William Haden to
a post oak corner N.E. on lands laid out to William Bond to a post
oak corner thence N.C. on lands laid out to William Gilham to a
Red oak corner N.E. to the market road comming on said road and
runing with said road to the Beginning — it being part of a tract origin-
ally granted to Samuel Bolling being a part of 232 acres of land
by His Excellency William Blackstone on the 4th day of September 1786
and has been conveyed down through different hands to the said
Eli Baldwin. — Together with all and singular the rights members
demesnes and hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have & to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Sepe
