State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that Enoch Benson of Greenville District & State of said for & in consideration of one Hundred Dollars to me in Paid in hand by Young Griffin of the State & District Before mentioned have Bargained Sold & Released & by these presents do grant Bargain and Sell and release unto Young Griffin all that tract or parcel of land supposed to contain thirty Acres or the same more or less being & Situate as follow on the South Side of Enoree Beginning on a Hickory Corner then a Short line to red Oak Corner on Stovalls line thence along Stovalls line to the River thence up the River until it intersects the S<sup>r</sup> Young Griffins line thence along the S<sup>r</sup> Griffins line to the Beginning with all and Singular the rights more or less hereditaments or appertinances to the same Belonging or in any wise incident to have and to Hold all and Singular the Premises before mentioned unto the S<sup>r</sup> Young Griffin his heirs Executors admors or assigns I bind My Self my Executors administrators my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the S<sup>r</sup> Young Griffin his heirs Executors admors or assigns against me Self my heirs Executors admors or any other person from lawfully claiming or claiming the same or any part thereof Signed Sealed & delivered this 27<sup>th</sup> May 1815 in presence of us Salathiel Clement, Francis Adams & Enoch Benson
