Hooper in the year 1786 containing 454 Acres Beginning at a red oak a Conditional Corner thence N 28 W 67 paces a brick & chain to a stake by a small pine on S Stegalls line thence South by Spring Creek 32 chains 50 links to a white oak thence S 75 E 20 chains 75 links to the Beginning - Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appertinances to the & premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold & to and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Richard Stegall his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & administrators to
