Ligon of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings to me in hand paid by John Blasingame of the district and State aforesaid have bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land containing Three Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the district aforesaid and on Saluda River Beginning on a stone near the bank of a small Creek thence up said Creek with its Meanders to a red oak on the north side of said Creek thence South 56 degrees west 5 Chains ^{50 links} to a long stone thence South 80 degrees west 4 Chains 50 links to a post oak thence South 80 degrees west 6 Chain 50 links to the Beginning Said tract bounded at the time of the original Survey by vacant lands originally granted to William Benson it being part of said tract as a plat herewith annexed and represented together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises before mentioned unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof hereby warranting & defending the same — Witness my hand and Seal this third day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen and in the forty first year of the Independancy of the United States of America Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of _____ John T. Bacon of Charlotte County of the State of Virginia for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Gov. John Blasingame of Greenville district in the State aforesaid. Have bargained sold and delivered & by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said John Blasingame a certain negro man named Jacob about twenty three or four years of age five feet eight or ten Inches high black complexion which said negro man I do hereby warrant and forever defend unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns forever free and clear of any impediment or incumbrance whatever Witness my hand and Seal this fifth day of November one thousand eight hundred and fifteen Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of Jeremiah C. Cleveland & J. D. Gibreath
