Know all men by these presents that I Joshua Thompson of the district  
of Greenville & State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina have for an Inconsideration of  
three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James M<sup>r</sup> Kenzie of the dist<sup>ct</sup> &  
State aforesaid granted bargained sold relinquishd & released unto the S<sup>d</sup>  
M<sup>r</sup> Kenzie & do by these presents grant bargain sell relinquish & release unto  
the S<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Kenzie the following tract or parcels of Land To wit Imprimis  
one tract of Land Situated lying & being in the dist<sup>ct</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> containing one hundred  
acres to the same more or less granted by James H<sup>is</sup> to one Samford by his deed  
bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> of Oct. one thousand eight hundred & eight Rec<sup>d</sup> in the off  
ice of Misone conveyance of the S<sup>d</sup> dist<sup>ct</sup> on the 30<sup>th</sup> of Oct 1810 & certified  
by Geo<sup>r</sup> Earle Register of the same the S<sup>d</sup> hundred acres being a part of three  
hundred acres originally granted to John Lafferty and signed by his  
Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the 6<sup>th</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1788 as by a plat thereunto  
will more fully appear and laid out unto the S<sup>d</sup> Samford as follows begin  
ning on a red oak on the North Side of quart Branch & running nearly  
South to a pine knot corner on Jacob Blacks corner thence on the  
original line to the corner thence on the original line to the S<sup>d</sup> East branch  
thence up the said branch to the beginning corner also all that tract  
or parcel of Land containing Twenty Five acres to the same more or less  
lying together with the tract already described on the water of Reedy  
River in the district aforesaid the same having been originally granted  
John Lafferty & granted unto the said one Samford by George Owen on  
the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1806 Recorded in the office of Misone conveyance on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of  
Oct 1810 & Examined & Certified by George W<sup>ill</sup> Earle Register of the same  
in the district & State aforesaid which said tract hath the boundaries as follows  
beginning on the North side of Quart branch & running on Thompson line to a  
pine & D. thence on Bondas line to a black oak corner on the said Bondas line from  
hence thence along a conditional line to the said Quart branch from thence down the  
branch to the beginning the said two tracts being fully granted by the S<sup>d</sup>  
Joshua Thompson unto the said James M<sup>r</sup> Kenzie together with all & singular  
"His" Rights houses & Improvements of every kind belonging or in anywise  
appertaining to said Land To have & to hold the S<sup>d</sup> tracts of Land hereby granted
