Sixty two acres to the same use or use, being the N. end of a
Survey granted to Augustus Merrick bearing date July
13th 1787 and by him conveyed to Wadsworth & Turpin
& by them to George Lucas, and by him to James Buller
and by him to Charles Whitten, and by him to my Father
Edward Stuart, and by him bequeathed by Deed of
Gift to me. Together with all and singular the right, man-
ners hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging
in any wise appertaining, To have and to hold the
above mentioned premises unto the said George by him his
heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself
my heirs executors or Administrators to warrant & defend
the said premises to the said George his heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs, and against every person or
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this second day of January in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &
Seventeen. And forty first year of American Independence
Signed Sealed & delivered in presence of. William Stewart
Thomas Barton Junr. Edward Stuart Alexander Ross
