Kilgore's line N 62 W 25 to a R. C. 3X thence S 30 W 25.50 to a R O 3X and the S. 35 E 62 to the beginning Post oak corner which Includes the full land to be conveyed be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights menbers hereditaments and appertinances unto the Said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the Said William M Crimes his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend the above described premises unto the Said William M Crimes, his heirs Executors administrators & assigns forever against, my self my heirs Executors administrators & assigns & against any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
