 Wright of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of three  
 hundred & Eighty one dollars to me in hand paid by Prince (a free negro legally  
 emancipated by Benj<sup>n</sup> Arnold his former master which will more fully appear  
 by the records at Greenville Court House) of the State & district aforesaid have  
 granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
 and release unto the Said Prince all that Plantation or tract of land containing  
 one hundred and twenty seven acres (more or less) situate in the district aforesaid  
 lying on the South fork of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River beginning <sup>at a stak</sup>  
 c. 3X on said creek running thence N 32 E 34. 00 to a post oak 3X thence S 59<sup>o</sup>  
 Thomas Estis' land there abouts 162.817.10 to a rock 3X thence S 28 E 53.00 to a 403+ boundary on  
 E. 39. 00 to a small hickory 3X bounding on Benjamin Arnold's land thence up  
 the meanders of said Creek to the beginning; Together with all and singular  
 the rights, members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises  
 belonging in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and  
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the Said Free negro Prince  
 his heirs and assigns forever, & I do hereby bind myself my heirs & executors &  
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the prem-  
 ises before mentioned unto the Said Free Prince against myself, my  
 heirs and against every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal this twenty ninth da-  
 y of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seventeen & in  
 the forty first year of the Independence of the United States of America, signed  
 Sealed and delivered in the presence of
