Now all men by their parents that are Lazarus Jones ^{Relict of Jones} of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid by Joseph Goodwin of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid have Granted bargained Sold and released, & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Joseph Goodwin all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid on both of the North fork of the river's Mill Creek waters of the North of Saluda River, it being surveyed for William Stringer & granted to James Rutherford, by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq Governor of South Carolina, the first day of October 1808. Containing ^{one} Thousand Seven hundred and ninety Two, & bound as follows
 VV. beginning at a Chestnut Corner Running S 59 1/4 chs to a Chestnut Corner, thence N. 36 1/4 chs. 50 links Sowerwood Corner thence S. 70 N. 35 chains to a Stake thence N. 5 N. 22 chs to a Stake thence N. 85 E 5 chains to a hickory corner, thence N 29 5/4 chains to a poplar corner, thence at 58 8 25 chs to a Stake thence 363 chains to the beginning corner, containing Two Hundred acres Together with all and singular the rights members hindertments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise ^{incident or} appertaining, to have and, ^{to hold all,} singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Goodwin his heirs
