 being privately and separately examined by me did declare that she does freely &
 voluntarily without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever
 Renounce release & forever relinquish unto George Green his heirs & assigns all her
 Interest & estate & also all her right & claim of dower of a certain tract of land lying
 & being in the District of Greenville on the Enoree River containing Four
 hundred and fifty Acres Signed Sealed and acknowledged before me this
 the Twenty fifth day of October 1817—

 Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of five hundred & fifty dollars to me
 paid by John Green of Greenville District & the State aforesaid having granted bargained
 sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the S^r John
 Green all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and eighty seven acres
 be the same more or less being part of a tract of land containing six hundred & forty
 acres originally granted to Henry Benson on the sixteenth day of July in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four by his Excellency
 Benjamin Guerard lying and being in Greenville District in the State aforesaid
 on the south side of Enoree River bounded as follows beginning at a stake
 on the south bank of Enoree River running thence South fifty west sixty
 two chains to a red oak corner original corner of said land running thence
 North thirty west fifty chains to a Spanish oak corner on the north bank of the
 third branch that the line crosses near an original red oak corner thence down
 said branch as its meanders to the said river thence down said river as its meander
 unto the beginning stake corner reference being had to the original grant
 & plat will make it more fully appear Together with all and singular the
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises be-
 longing or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John
 Green his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Execu-
 tors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said John Green his heirs & assigns
 and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
