I do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern that Nancy Benson the wife of Henry Benson did this day appear before me & upon being privately & separately Examined by me did declare that she does fully voluntarily and without any compulsion duress or fear of any person or persons whatsoever Renounce release and forever Relinquish unto John Green his heirs and assigns all her interest & Estate & also all her Right & claim of dower of a certain tract of land lying & being in the district aforesaid on the Crook River containing in or near hundred & eighty seven acres Given under my hand this the twenty fifth day of October 1817. Know all men by these presents that I William Toney of the State and district aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Tounes of the same place have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Tounes all that Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and two acres being part of a tract of land granted to ~~Wm~~ Scoggin by his Excellency B. Beaufort Governor of the State aforesaid and dated the fifteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty four Beginning at a white oak Branch corner thence N 46° Chain to a Spanish oak thence west 88 chs to a Stake thence S 15° E 42 chain to a oak thence S 45° E 23 chain to a Crab Apple Tree on Thompsons line thence N 44° E 7 chains to the beginning the above mentioned land lying and being on the waters of the Golden Grove Creek together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Tounes his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said John Tounes his heirs and assigns against
