I Thomas Dayne Sheriff of Greenville District and State  
of said said Greeting Whereas by virtue of an order  
issued out of the court of common pleas held for the  
said District tested the second day of November in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and fifty  
at the suit of Robert Alexander one of the heirs of  
James Seaborn Decd. against Mary Seaborn the  
widow by a writ of partition which order directed that  
I should on the first Monday in January then next  
ensuing after having given lawful notice thereof pro-  
vide to sell the lands of James Seaborn Decd. a grievable  
to the returne of the Commissioners in convenient tracts  
lots or Plantations upon a credit of twelve months and  
that the money arising from said Sales be divided  
between the parties interested pursuant to the directions  
of the act of assembly in obedience to the said order  
I have seized and taken of the lands of the said  
James Seaborn a tract of one Hundred and Eighty  
one acres more or less described as lot N<sup>o</sup> 146 situate  
in Greenville District on Bridge fork the waters of  
Gilderis creek and on a small branch of Sloney creek begin-  
ning on a Spanish oak running thence S. 55 W. 54 to a stake  
thence S. 45 E. 13.50 links to a Stake thence N. 80 E 68 to a  
pine thence N. 25 E. 6.70 links to a white oak thence N 45
