W. 18. 55. a crop the Rocky fork to a post Oak & thence S. 70. E. 20 ch a crop the said Rocky fork to a post Oak & thence N. 20. E. 33 ch to a Red Oak & thence S. 66. W. 15 ch to a poplar & thence S. 77. W. 13 ch. to the beginning including the Plantation whereon the said William Holliday now lives containing Fifty Acres or the same more or less together with all & singular the rights members & appurtenances to the said premises being or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Roberts his heirs & assigns forever & do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Roberts his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & every other person or persons who so ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 21st day of February 1818 in presence of
