

State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I Jerry Davis of the District of Pendleton State aforesaid for & in consideration of the Sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Amos Ladd Sutherland all of the same State & District have bargained sold & Released & by these presents do grant bargain sell Release unto the said Amos Ladd Sutherland a certain parcel or tract of Land containing one Hundred & one acres Situate in the District of Greenville & State aforesaid on the South fork of Saluda River Beginning on the North side of said River on a white pine thence a Strat Line to a Maple thence thirty five Degrees East and thirty seven Chances to a Hickory thence South fifty five Degrees East & thirty five Chances & fifty links to a white pine on the bank of the River thence up the Meanders of the River to the beginning together with all & singular the Rights members hereunto & appertainances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Amos Ladd Sutherland his heirs & assigns forever I do hereby bid & my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & defend all & singular the premises unto the said Amos Ladd Sutherland his heirs & assigns against my self Jerry Davis & against any person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand & Seal this Twenty Eight day of January Anno Domini Eighteen Hundred & Sixty & of the sovereignty of the United States the 34 & 35 Year witness present
