Claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand  
and Seal this thirtieth day of July in the Year of our Lord one Thousand  
Eight hundred and four in the 29<sup>th</sup> of American Independence

& seventy acres beginning on a Maple corner thence S. 58. W. 59. 50 to a black  
corner thence N. 20 E. 15. 20 to post oak corner S. 57 W. 17 to a pine  
corner thence N. 25 W. 26 to a black oak corner then N. 57. E. 34. 25 to  
a post oak corner thence S. 33 E to the creek to a persimmon then up the  
Creek the various courses thereof to the beginning containing one Hundred &  
=Seventy two Acres together with all & singular the rights members & appurten-  
ances therunto belonging or in any wise incident therunto to have & to hold  
all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the S. John Chamneys his  
heirs or assigns. & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administra-  
=tors to warrant & forever defend the S. premises before mentioned unto  
the S. John Chamneys his heirs & assigns against any self my heirs and  
assigns & all other persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim part of the
