217 The State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I William Brasher of the District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of two Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Pascal Rutledge of Said District & State aforesaid have Granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Pascal Rutledge all that Tract or parcel of Land situate in the District & State aforesaid on Bakers Creek waters of Ruddy river & bounded as follows beginning at a Spanish Oak corner on the original line & running N. 25 E. on S. line to a Post Oak corner from thence Northward to an ash on the North Bank of S. Bakers Creek at the Mouth of the big branch thence running up & bounding on the S. big Branch to a Maple corner on the South Bank of S. Branch thence N. 27 E. a Stake on the original line from thence N. 60 W. on the S. Original line a Stake corner from thence to a Post Oak corner of the S. Land granted to S. Gilliam from thence N. 62 W. 15 chains to a Stake corner thence S. 28 W. to a Post Oak corner being 52 chains from thence South Eastward to the beginning including one Hundred & fifty Acres of Land more or less together with all & singular the Rights Members hereditaments & Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Pascal Rutledge his heirs and assigns forever & I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to Warrant & forever defend all & singular the premises unto the said Pascal Rutledge his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand & Seal this the seventeenth day of August in the Year of our Lord, & in the Thirty sixth year of American Independence
