

Memorandum that on the tenth day of June 1812 Pascal Dacus came before me I being duly Sworn as the Law directs and South on S^d oath that he was present & did see Joseph Jackson Sign & affix act and deed deliver the within deed of conveyance for the use & purpose therein mentioned and that he also saw John Croft & Pascal Rutledge with himself subscribe their names as Witnesses to the same Sworn to & subscribed the day & date above written

219 Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Merritt of the State of South Carolina & Greenville District of the one part & Hiram Whitted of the State & District aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that for the Inconsideration of the Sum of Eleven Hundred Dollars in Hand paid by the said Hiram Whitted the receipt is hereby Acknowledged, hath bargained sold & delivered ^{into} by these presents bargain sold & delivered unto the said Hiram Whitted a Certain Tract or parcel of Land Containing by Estimation Two Hundred & Six Acres & half Laying & being in the State & District aforesaid on both sides of the North fork of Saluda River, Beginning on a Peach Tree on Williamsons line then running on Springers line round up the Cedar Mountain to Adamses Conditional line thence to a White Oak, corner thence by the said Duding line to the E. W. line to a White Oak thence S. 58^o E. to a Stake thence to the Beginning corner but remember that there are two Tracts of Land within the above boundary, the first Tract one Hundred & Six Acres & half, the other Tract one Hundred Acres making in the whole the Comp^lement of two Hundred Six & half Acres, the said Thomas Merritt do Warrant & Ever defend the rights & Titles of the above Tract of Land with all Water & Water Courses profits, Accidents & Appurtenances & whatsoever may belong to the aforesaid Premises from any claim or any person Lawfully claiming of the same, In Witness whereof I have here unto set my hand & Seal this 7. day of September A.D. 1816
