


State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that we Charles Fargason & Wife Patty Fargason of the State & District aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred & twenty five Dollars to us in hand paid by Hewlet Sullivan have Bargained Granted & sold & conveyed & by presents do Grant bargain & sell & confirm unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his heirs & assigns a certain parcel or tract of Land containing jitty Acres & being part of a Tract Originally Granted to Charles Sullivan Situate in Greenville District on Reddy river adjoining said Hewlet Sullivan on the north & West it being the Plantation we now live on it being two shares of 8 Tract out of five shares together with all & singular the rights Members & Appurtenances To have & to hold all & singular the premises before Mentioned unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & assigns to warrant & defend all & singular the above mentioned premises unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & assigns & against all & every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in Witness Whereof we have hereunto set Our hands & seals this 28th day of January 1817 Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence of
