

This Intenture made this tenth day of January one Thousand Seven Hundred & Twenty three & in the Eighteenth year of the Independence of the United States of America Between Benjamin Kilgore Junior of the one part, and Silas Brock of the other part, both of the State of S. Carolina Greenville County. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Kilgore Junior for & in consideration of the sum of two pounds nine shillings & two pence Sterling money to him in hand well & truly paid by the said Silas Brock the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & he the said Benjamin Kilgore doth hereby Bargain sell & by these Presents doth Give Grant sell & deliver unto the said Silas Brock his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns for ever one certain Tract or Parcel of land situate lying & being on the S<sup>t</sup> side of Rockey Creek Waters of Environs more or less on both sides of the old Boundary line containing one hundred Acres of land more or less it being a part of a Tract of 1000 acres of Land Granted to the said Benjamin Kilgore Junior the Third day of September 1792 by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor over the said State at that time & recorded in the Secretarys Office Grant Book F<sup>1</sup> S<sup>5</sup> Page 149 & hath such shape form bounings & boundings as the a bove Plate Represents together to have hold use Occupij Posses & enjoy all & singular the a bove sold Land & Promises together with all the profits Advantages & hereditaments thereunto belonging or in any ways appertaining unto him the said Silas Brock his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns & the said Benjamin Kilgore Junr. for himself his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns doth covenant & agree to & with the said Silas Brock he his heirs or assigns may Possess the above said Land with all its profits & appertinences without any denial of him the said Benjamin Kilgore Junr. his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns or either of them & the said Benjamin Kilgore Junior doth not agree to warrant the above sold land from none other persons but from himself his heirs Administrators Executors [The corner of the deed containing the witness names torn off] . . . . .
