Administrators or assigns do and shall well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the S^r Richard Thurston his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns full sum of fifteen hundred Dollars with the Lawfull Interest from this Date on or before the Twenty fifth Day of December 1820 Without any Deduction or Abatement whatsoever for or by reason of any Taxes or Assessment whatsoever Either Ordinary or Extraordinary All ready imposed or hereafter to be imposed on the said premises or any part thereof that then & from thence forward these presents Determined and be utterly null and Void to all intents & purposes and the S^r John Busclark for himself his heirs Exors. & Administrators both Covenant promise grant & agree to and with the S^r Rich. Thurston his Exors. Administrators & Assigns that he the said John Busclark his heirs Exors. or Administrators shall & will well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the S^r R. Thurston his Exors. Administrators or assigns the S^r sum of fifteen hundred Dollars with legal Interest for the same on or before the 25 day of December 1825 according to the true intent & meaning of these presents and also that he the S^r Richard Thurston his Exors. Administrators & Assigns shall & may at all times after Default shall be made in payment of the said fifteen hundred Dollars with legal Interest or any part thereof at the time or times mentioned shall be at liberty to sell or cause to be publicly sold the whole or any part of the above mentioned premises until the above named fifteen hundred Dollars with Interest & Costs which may arise thereon come under my hand & seal this 1st Day of Jan^y 1818
