John Greer of the State & District aforesaid do hereby bargain sell and
release unto the s^d John Greer his Heirs & assigns for ever all that
tract or parcel of land supposed to contain sixty acres more
or less being a part of a tract of 1262 acres originally granted
to Robert Burdisong Situate in the State & District aforesaid
between two small branches of Acropfen Creek Waters of Guddens
Creek bounding on the East side of the antient boundary line on
the s^d by s^d Steven X Averings land & on the S. & S. E. by s^d Greer &
Vances lands beginning on a Sweet gum on the E. side of a small
branch on s^d Greers land & runs in s^d line N 65. E. 17.6. over a small
branch to a White Oak 3x Thence up the meanders of s^d branch to a pine
3x at the head thereof thence N 79. W. 6. 6h: to a P. O. 3x on the old bou-
ndary line thence S. on s^d line 12 6h: to a P. O. 3x thence S. 46. E. 10.
50. to a P. O. 3x at the head of the first mentioned branch thence
