

Down the meanders of D. branch to the beginning second gum corner which includes the whole land to be conveyed by the same more or less together with all & singular the rights members incidents and appurtenances thereto belong in or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend the above described land unto the D<sup>r</sup> John Green his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1811 in the 35<sup>th</sup> Year of the Independance of the United States of America.
