of Two hundred Dollars to me paid by John Marshall of the State  
of South Carolina & District of Pendleton have Granted Bargained  
sold & Relied on by these presents do Grant Bargain sell Release  
& Convey unto John Marshall a certain tract of land containing one  
hundred & twenty acres more or less situated on the North bank of the  
South fork of Saluda River & Dot. Beginning on Joseph Sanders corner  
Spruce pine on the Pa River at the Mouth of the Roaring Branch  
from thence a long hard line to his corner White Oak from  
thence a long a Line of Marked tree nearly a North East Line  
to the line of said Blyth Grant from thence along one of Dr. Grants  
to him in his line from thence a long hard line to the River  
from thence up the Pa River to the beginning To have & to hold  
all and singular the rights & members hereditaments & appurtenances  
unto the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have  
& to hold all & singular the granted premises as before mentioned  
unto John Marshall his Heirs & assigns forever & do hereby Bind  
myself my Heirs Executors & Administrators & assigns to warrant and  
and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said John  
Marshall his Heirs & assigns against my self my heirs & assigns and  
Every other person what so ever lawfully claiming or to claim the
