277 South Carolina To all whom these presents shall come I Thos<sup>d</sup> Payne  
Sheriff of Greenville district and State aforesaid send greeting wheresby virtue  
of an order issued out of the court of common pleas held for said district testad  
the second day of in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
& fifteen at the suit of Robt Alexander one of the heirs of James Seaborn  
dec<sup>d</sup> aq<sup>r</sup> Mary Seaborn the widow by a writ of partition which  
order directed that I should on the first monday in January next  
eswaring after having given lawful notice thereof proceed to sell the land  
of James Seaborn dec<sup>d</sup> agreeable to the return of the commissioners in  
convenient tracts Lots or Plantations upon a credit of twelve months  
and that the money arising from said sales be divided between the parties  
interested pursuant to the directions of the act of assembly in obedience  
to sd order I have sayed & taken of the lands of the sd James Seaborn  
a tract of two hundred & twenty four acres more or less, described as Lot No<sup>o</sup> 6  
situate in Greenville district on a small branch of Maple Creek begin  
ning on a post oak running thence N<sup>o</sup> 20 W<sup>o</sup> 24 to a red oak, thence  
N<sup>o</sup> 50 W<sup>o</sup> 18 to a post oak, thence S<sup>o</sup> 70 W<sup>o</sup> 7 to a pine, thence S<sup>o</sup> 50 W<sup>o</sup> 24  
to a pine, thence S<sup>o</sup> 20 W<sup>o</sup> 30 to a stake, thence S<sup>o</sup> 42 E<sup>o</sup> 33:50 thence to a stake,  
thence N<sup>o</sup> 52 E<sup>o</sup> 50 thence to the beginning, as may appear by the  
aforegoing plat - And whereas the sd premises with their appurtenances  
since the seizure by me made by virtue of the sd order of court before mentioned  
have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by  
Walton Knight of the district of Greenville for the sum of one hundred &  
forty dollars & the title by sd Knight directed to be made to Jesse Reed & Asa Reed  
being the highest sum that was bid for therefor. Now I know by that I have the  
Payne sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said order of court aforesaid to me  
directed & delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the statute in such case  
made & provided & for & in consideration of the said sum of one hundred & forty  
dollars to me on hand paid or secured to be paid by the sd Walton Knight  
the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted  
bargained and sold by these presents to grant bargain & sell unto the  
Jesse Reed & Asa Reed their heirs & assigns forever the sd tract piece of land  
& land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title & interest  
which the sd James Seaborn or his heirs of right had of in it to the same
