Williams all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the district & state aforesaid containing thirty two acres of land be the same more or less on the north side of Saluda river beginning at an oak corner on the bank of S^r. river & runs on Elijah Bennett's line N 63 E 27 ch^s to a red oak 3 X on Brumby's line thence on S. line S 80 E 17 to a red oak thence N 80 E 35 0. to a poplar 3 X on the bank of Pulpills Spring branch thence down the meander of S^r. branch to a hickory 3 X on the bank of S^r. river thence up the meander of the river to the beginning thence S. W. across the river to a maple 3 X on the south bank of the river thence down the meander of the S^r. bank of S^r. river to John Clement's corner thence across the river to the north bank thence up the bank of the river to the mouth of Pulpills branch including some Islands and a fishery known by the name of Ambrose Blackbore fishery.
