Witness that the d^r John Adams for the consideration of the sum of eighty dollars to him in hand paid by the d^r Nathan Massey at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold released and confirmed and doth bargain sell release & confirm by these presents unto the said Nathan Massey his heirs & assigns part of a tract of land lying on North Rabun's creek originally granted to John McKnight containing eighty acres be the same more or less in the district aforesaid beginning on a pine station running S. 20 E. 60 to a post oak, thence S. 40 N. 24 to a hickory, thence N. 44 W. 29 to a white oak station, thence a straight line to the pine station the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members & appurtenances thereof to d^r tract of land being or in any wise belonging or appertaining & remainders, rents & profits thereof and of every part thereof to have & to hold the d^r tract & all & singular the premises & appurtenances belonging as aforesaid & every part thereof unto the d^r Nathan Massey his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and benefit of the d^r Nathan Massey his heirs & assigns forever, and the d^r John Adams his heirs & assigns, all & every person or persons
