Thomas Peden & Sarah Peden the wife of the said Thomas of  
Chester district in the state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one  
thousand dollars to us paid by James Martin of Laurens district in  
the state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released & by  
these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the s<sup>d</sup> James Martin  
all that plantation or tract of land containing two hundred & sixty  
four acres more or less lying and being in the district of Greenville  
on the Waters of Reedy River being part of a tract of land of six  
hundred & forty acres originally granted to David Milling the grant  
bearing date the twenty first day of January in the year of  
our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty four & convey'd  
by s<sup>d</sup> David Milling to the above named Thomas Peden it being  
the west part of the s<sup>d</sup> tract or original grant adjoining land  
owned by Robert Peden & Moses White Peden being tracts of the  
original grant also John Alexander together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to  
the s<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said James Martin his heirs and assigns forever and we  
do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant  
and defend all and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the  
s<sup>d</sup> James Martin his heirs & assigns against ourselves our heirs  
and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof. Witness our hands & seals this first day of  
December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & sixteen  
and in the forty first year of the American Independence. Signed
