To all whom these presents shall come I Thomas Payne Sheriff of Greenville district & state aforesaid send greeting whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the court of common pleas held for the district of Greenville the first Monday after the fourth Monday in March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seventeen at the suit of Andrew Bridges exponer against John Fair & Saml. Fair to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands & tenements of John Fair Saml. Fair to levy the sum of fifty five dollars with interest damage & costs, I have seized & taken of the lands & tenements of the said Saml. Fair all that certain piece parcel & tract of land containing two hundred & four acres or less situate & lying in the district of Greenville on the waters of the Enoe adjoining Robert Benson's land, N.W.P. Pool. Thornton. Benson. & same have with such bounds & buttinnes as are laid down in a plat in the hands of said Fair. And whereas the same premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias by you mentioned have been exposed to sale at public vendue, & purchased by John P. Pool of the district of Greenville for the sum of thirty one dollars to me in hand paid, & being the highest sum that was bidden therefor. Now know ye that I Thomas Payne Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed & delivered as aforesaid & by virtue of the statute in such case made & provided & for in consideration of the said sum of thirty one dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said John P. Pool the receipt & payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John P. Pool his heirs & assigns forever the said tract piece & parcel of land with its appurtenances & all the estate right title & interest which the said Saml. Fair of right had of, in & to the same. To have & to hold the said piece parcel & tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said John P. Pool his heirs & assigns forever, as fully & absolutely as I the said Thos. Payne might could, or ought to grant, bargain & sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid & the said writ of fieri facias, or otherwise. In witness whereof I the said Thos.
