ner, of the district of Greenville & state afores^d have granted bargain-
-ined sold & released & by these presents, do grant bargain sell
and release unto the said Joseph Turner a certain tract or parcel
of land containing two hundred & eight acres more or less lying and
being in the district of Greenville & state afores^d lying on the waters of hoop-
-er creek branch of Saluda beginning on a red oak on Cap^t Fair-
line running thence N 78 W 60 chains to a hickory thence N 22 W 77 ch^s.
to a small red oak thence N 42 E 22 ch^s. to a red oak on Isaac
Bradley line thence N 53 E 32 ch^s to a red oak thence N 41 E 12 ch^s
to a red oak near the mile post thence S 13 E 7 ch^s to a post oak
thence S 10 E 19 ch^s. 90 ch^s to a pine stump thence S 80 E 16 to a post oak
thence S 9 W 20 ch^s to the beginning red oak on Fair line Together
with all & singular the rights, members, incidents, & appur-
-tenances, unto the said land, belonging or in any wise incident
or appertaining to the same to have & to hold all & singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Turner his heirs, & assigns
forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Ex^{ors} & Adm^{rs} to wa-
-rant & forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned
before mentioned unto the s^d. Joseph Turner his heirs, & assigns forever
against myself my heirs, & assigns, & every other person lawfully
claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 2^d day of December 1818 & in the 42^d year of the
Independence of the United States of America. Signed sealed & delivered in the

South Carolina Greenville district personally appeared Henry
