



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Beginsing Sixtly on other tract situate in the S^d district containing
five hundred acres, more or less, originally granted to James Hite by
King at a red oak running thence S 30° W 106 to a Spanish oak 160
E 56 to a stump N 30 E 76.50 to a pine N 106 33.60 to a stake N 160 48.50
to the beginning. All which S lands were conveyed to me by John
Shirkpatrick on the 31st of August 1816 by Joshua Benson & Shirkpatrick,
part conveyed to me by a Deed bearing date 9th May 1817 Recorded in the
Clerk's office at Greenville June 2^d 1817. Together with all & singular
else the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances, to the S^d
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto &
to hold all & singular the premises by assignment unto the S^d Hugh Bailey
& Hugh McClemous their heirs & assigns forever And I do hereby bind
myself & my heirs, executors & adm^rs to warrant & defend all & singular
the said premises unto the S^d Hugh Bailey & Hugh McClemous their heirs
& assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other person whom
ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

bargain sell and release unto the said George Gordon, Three
certain lots of Land, situate lying and being in the Village of
Greenville Coast house in the State of South Carolina, known
and distinguished in the Plan of the said Village by the
numbers ¹⁶⁸ twenty seven, twenty nine and thirty one (N. 27. 29 & 31)
in the north West square of the said Village; Also an addition
of Forty feet to be annexed to the upper or north side of
