Beginning Sixthly one other tract situate in the S^d district containing
five hundred acres, more or less, originally granted to James Pitt, begin-
ning at a red oak running thence S 90° W 136 to a spanish oak S 60
E 56 to a stump N 30 E 76.50 to a pine N 10 W 33.60 to a stake N 16 W 48.50
to the beginning. All which S^d lands were conveyed to me & one John
Hickpatrick on the 31st of August 1816 by Joshua Benson & Kirkpatrick,
part conveyed to me by deed bearing date 9th May 1817. Recorded in the
Clerk's office at Greenville June 2^d 1817. Together with all S^d singular
-car. the rights, members, incidents, & appurtenances, to the S^d
premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining I have
to hold all & singular the premises, before mentioned unto the S^d Hugh Bailey
& Hugh M^cClimous their heirs, & assigns forever and I do hereby bind
myself & my heirs, Exec^{rs} & Adm^{rs} to warrant & defend against all singular
the said premises, unto the S^d Hugh Bailey & Hugh M^cClimous their heirs,
& assigns against myself & my heirs, & against Every other person whom
-ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
