


South Carolina Greenville district, Know all men by these presents that I James
Taylor Sur. for and in consideration of one hundred and forty dollars to me paid
by B. Wilson of the district and state afores^d have bargained and sold unto Bennett
Wilson of the same state & district of Spartanburg a certain tract or parcel of
land lying in Greenville district on the waters of Mountain Creek containing
one hundred acres more or less Beginning on a black gum on the north side
of Mountain Creek & running to a post oak thence to a pine joining Cross
line thence west on the ridge to Russell's old line to Mountain Creek thence
down the meanders of said creek to the beginning. Containing one hundred
acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the said premises
=ss, hereditaments & appurtenances, therrunto belonging to the same unto
the said Bennett Wilson his heirs and assigns & I do bind myself my heirs
and assigns to warrant & forever to defend all the above mentioned
premises unto the s^d Bennett Wilson his heirs and assigns from all
other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and my
seal this first day of December 1815 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and fifteen signed sealed in the presence of us. The underlined done

any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce
releas and foreve^r relinquish unto the within named Bennett Wilson
his heirs and assigns all her interest and estate & also all her right and
claim of dower of in or to all & singular the premises within mentioned
and released. Given under my hand & seal this 2^d day of December 1815
