


24. Before me the subscribing Justice, being duly sworn according to law on his oath

The ²⁴ State of South Carolina, Know all men by these Presents that William Gill
of Greenville district, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of thirty five
dollars to me paid by Walker Brock, Have granted bargained sold, released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Walker
Brock one certain Lot of Land Situate lying and being in the village at Green
ville Courthouse in the State of S. Carolina, known and distinguished in the
Plan of the said Village as laid out by "Vandy Mcbee" and filed in the Clerk,
Office of the said courted by the number there being (No. 13.) in the south West square
of the said Village, Beginning at a Stake corner, on Broad Street, running thence
S. 16° West, one hundred and forty feet along Jackson Street to a Stake, thence
S. 74° E. one hundred and seventeen and an half feet to a Stake, thence N. 16° E. 140
feet to a Stake thence N. 74° W. 117 feet to the beginning, containing about half
an acre. Together with all and singular the rights, members, habitaments &
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur
tenance: To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Walker Brock his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant & for ever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Walker Brock
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every person
whoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
Will sign my hand and Seal, the eighth day of August in the year of
our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighteen, and in the
fifty third year of the Independence of the United States of America.
