Bounding as follows Beginning on Black Oak on Charter Ets. line and
running S. 10. W. 57.50 to a White Oak 34 thence N. 80 W. 37 to a Post Oak
pinning land of the heirs of Larken Tarrant, thence N. 43. E 15 to a small
 Hickory 34, thence N. 25 W. 30 to a Rock 34, thence N. 60 E 25 to a Stake on
Horseshoe Bristolers line, thence S. 89 E. 25. 00. to the beginning. Together
with all and singular the premises before mentioned, with the rights mem-
bers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Micajah Jordan
his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself
my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said Micajah Jordan his
heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & assigns and against every
