



N 30. W. 10. ch. 25 lh. to a chestnut thence N 70. W. 19 ch. 75 lh. to a B. O.
thence N 35 W 50 ch. to a chestnut thence S 55 W. 13 ch. to a chestnut (at
Cock Creek) thence to the beginning. Containing by estimation one hundred
& ninety eight acres more or less it being lands conveyed to me by
