Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all & singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John Gordon his heirs and assigns forever. And I Obadiah Bolding do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said John Gordon his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and Seal this 4th March in the year of our Lord 1820 -
