Know all men by these presents that I John Dickerson "senr." of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Williams of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel Williams a Plantation and tract of land wherein said Dickerson now lives beginning at a Stake on an old line of a tract of 860 acres surveyed for said Pyle thence to a Stake 34 S 82 E 22 on the line of M^r Bonner 27 acres thence S 80 W. crossing a branch 25^{ch} 00 to a line made for said Pyle thence E. 20. to a Stump 34 thence S 70 E. 34^{ch} to a B. O. 34 thence N. 35. E. 29^{ch} to a Stake 34 thence N. 52 W. 19^{ch} to a post oak 34 thence N. 28 E. 65^{ch} to a Pine Station thence in a direct line across to a B. O. 34 thence S. 77. W. 18^{ch} to a Pine 34 thence N. 30 W. 77^{ch} thence in a direct line to the beginning, 4 chains above an hickory Station on the old line aforesaid including the plantation and three hundred acres of land, be the same more or less - Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Williams his heirs and assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel Williams his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and assigns and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
