 the said premises unto the said Moses W. Pedem his heirs adm^{rs}. executors
 and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every other person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part

 and fifty cents to me in hand paid by Moses, ~~W.~~ Pedem of the said
 State and district to me in hand the receipt thereof is hereby acknow-
 -ledged that I have granted, bargained, sold, conveyed released
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto
 the said Moses W. Pedem a parcel of land containing one hundred
 and twenty nine acres it being a part of an original grant granted unto David
 Milling containing six hundred & forty acres situated and lying on the
 N. E. side of Reedy River and has such shapes and marks as will
 more fully appear by a plat of said grant &c. The said parcel of one
 hundred and twenty nine acres beginning on a stump running
 E 33 ch^s 33 lb^s to R. O. thence S 33 ch^s 33 lb^s thence W. 4 ch^s to a
 P. O. thence N 11 ch^s 50 lb^s to a stake in Thomas Pedem's field thence
 W. 20 ch^s to a stake X 3 thence N. 37 E 15 ch^s to a hickory thence N 33
