1821, and one of six hundred dollars payable Dec 25. 1822, for the
sum payment of which I do bind myself, my heirs, Exec^ts & Adm^rs and all
that tract and parcel of land which I bought of said Charles Dean
together with the shoal and all other things thenceunto belonging.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day
of December one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, also the said
Dean does agree not to close or bound to be closed the above
mortgage untill the last note falls due. Signed sealed & delivered in

in the district of Greenville in the state aforesaid on both sides of the
North fork of Saluda it being surveyed by and granted to John Westcott
by his excellency Benjamin Goad Esq^r Governor of the state of S. Carolina
the 16 day of July A.D. one thousand seven hundred & eighty four and
bounded as follows. W^m. Beginning on a black oak corner thence N 70°
E 38 ch. 42 lk. to a black oak corner thence N 20° W. 38 ch. 72 lk. to a
white oak corner, thence S 70° W. 38 ch. 72 lk. to a stake, thence S 20° E 38
ch. 42 lk. to the beginning corner containing one hundred & fifty
acres by the same more or less. Together with all & singular the
rights and immunitiess hereditaments & appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Alfred Hightower his heirs and assigns forever. And
