Beginning on a white oak corner on Barnetts line thence running N. W. on a white oak on said Barnetts line thence running N 22 W 17 ch 50 to a post oak corner thence S 81 W to a black jack corner thence running to a branch thence down the said branch to the creek to a stake corner thence down the creek to a chestnut corner thence to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.
