negro slaves known and called the names as follows, Wm, Rachael about
thirty years old and her two children, Bob & Rueta, Bob supposed to be
about eight years old, and Rueta supposed to be about six years old,
in the said James Blasingame & Polly Blasingame do warrant & give
afore the right and title of the said negro slaves to the said John
Hightower and his heirs forever with their increase we do also warrant
the said negroes to be sound & healthy. In witness whereof we have
hereunto set our hand, this 8 day of August in the year of our
Lord 1820. to W. Blasingame Jas. Blasingame

acknowledged hath sold, conveyed, & confirmed a certain tract
of land containing two hundred & fifty acres more or less, lying
in the district of Greenville & state of S. Carolina on the head waters
of Coosawattee river, bounded as follows; on the North by J. Edwards on the S. by
McCormicks on the East by, formerly, L. Landreth on the W. formerly, McClellan
horns lying on both sides the road, which s^d tract or parcel of land, with
tenements, woods, water, mines, minerals & appurtenances thereto belonging
now or in any wise incident to the same. To have & to hold the afores
mentioned premises to said David L. Jr. Daniel his heirs & assigns forever,
and I the said John Edwards do warrant and defend the said premises
unto s^d D. L. Jr. Daniel his heirs or assigns against the claim of me or
my heirs, or any other person or persons whatsoever. In testimony whereof
