Beginning at a chestnut Blasingame corner, thence with his line N 65 W 16 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 lks to a hickory, thence S 22 W 10 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 lks to a pine thence S 35 W 14 ch<sup>s</sup> to a post oak, thence N 75 W 40 ch<sup>s</sup> to a hickory thence N 30 W 2 ch<sup>s</sup> to a stake on Johnsons line, thence with his line N 7 W 5 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 lks to a Post oak near the Tugate road, thence N 82 E along the road 19 ch<sup>s</sup> 38 lks to a chestnut, thence N 69 E 15 ch<sup>s</sup> to a post oak thence N 50 E 7 ch<sup>s</sup> to a gum bush near the creek thence N 70 E 10 ch<sup>s</sup> to a Post oak, thence S 45 E to the beginning, containing one hundred and fifty acres <sup>be the same</sup> more or less, being part of two tracts of land originally granted to Robert Goodwin and from him conveyed to me.
