173 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that Aaron Stump of Gummille district and state aforesaid for & in consideration of four hundred dollars to me paid by Henry Stump of Gummille district in the state aforesaid. I have granted bargained & sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Henry Stump a certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty acres it being part of a tract of land bought from Henry Chamblis by said Aaron Stump; beginning on a hickory running N 19 E 15:50 to hickory thence N 5 E 9 to Roak thence W 20:5 to a stake thence S 13 to a Roak thence on such course & distance to the beginning as will take in inclose the fifty acres. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises, before mentioned unto the said Henry Stump his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Stump his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim any part thereof.
