 of the sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand by Perry McHenry of  
 the said district and state aforesaid have granted bargained sold conveyed  
 and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Perry McHenry a  
 Plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the district &  
 State aforesaid On the E<sup>o</sup> side of Rocky creek waters of Enoree river  
 it being part of a tract originally granted to Tho<sup>s</sup> Bridgman & assigned  
 by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq<sup>r</sup> bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> of  
 April one thousand seven hundred and ninety two. Recorded in  
 Book D No 5 Page 519... The land to be conveyed begins on the  
 Oak and oak & runs S 75 E 25: 50 to stake then S 23 W 21: 50 to  
 Post Oak 3 x then S 57 W 10 to Post Oak 3 x then due W 37 ch then  
 N 10 E 35 ch to said creek then down the various <sup>courses</sup> of said creek to  
 the Beginning course the said land has been conveyed through different  
 hands down to the said Abner Smith including 200 acres both more  
 or less. Together with all and singular the rights members  
 hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
 wise appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular the premises  
 here mentioned unto the said Perry McHenry his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> Adm<sup>ors</sup> or  
 Assigns. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> Adm<sup>ors</sup> or Assigns  
 to warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises before  
 mentioned unto the said Perry McHenry his heirs or assigns against any  
 self my heirs or assigns & against any other person or persons lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness where  
 of I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirteen & 8<sup>th</sup> year  
 of American Independence, Signed sealed & delivered in presence of us.
