

Certain Plantation or tract of land containing eighty acres more or less lying in the district & state aforesaid on Rocky creek of Curran River and hath such boundaries whereas, Beginning on a chestnut corner standing on bank of Maple branch then up 2^d Branch the branch to be the line up to where Bunell Hudsons line crosses branch then along said line to spanish oak corner made by Pleasant Hudson thence along a conditional line made between Sam^l Walker & Watsons land across Rocky Creek to gum corner thence across 2^d creek to the Beginning chestnut corner. Together with all and singular the rights, liberties, tenements, and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto the 2^d Sa^r Walker his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Exors & admors to warrant and prove defend all & singular the 2^d premises unto the said James Watson his heirs & assigns, against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this 25th day of Jan^r 1815.

This Indenture made this eight day of february in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine between John Brasil of the state of Tennessee and white County of one part and Abner Center of the state of south Carolina and Greenville District of the other part witnesseth that I John Brasil for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Abner Center of the state of south Carolina and district of Greenville witnesseth that said John Brasil of the state of Tennessee white County hath granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Abner Center a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the state of south Carolina and District of Greenville and on the branches of south Tyger River beginning on a pile of rocks running thence crossing a flat rock N. 50 E. 47 Cha. and 30 links to large red oak thence S. 55 E. 15 chains and fifty links to a locust thence N. 58 west 48 chains 30 links to a spanish oak thence S. 5 W. 5 chains and 50 links to a poplar thence N. 80 W. 18 chains to the beginning Rock containing sixty five acres more or less with all and singular the rights and premises
